Celebrating the Golden Age of Motoring, the third annual Westlake Village Concours D'Elegance honored the final season of the acclaimed PBS series *Downton Abbey*. Set amid the manicured grounds of the Four Seasons Hotel Westlake Village, the event offered visitors the chance to inspect some of the most coveted vintage collectable cars in the world, including a 1961 Aston Martin DB4 GT Zagato, valued at \$17 million, and one of only two existing 1953 Cadillac Series 62s, with a stunning European body by Ghia and a powerful Cadillac motor and chassis.
